General Overview

Fatih High School of Teachers was incorporated into Karadeniz Technical University under the name of "Fatih Faculty of Education" with the decree law no 2547 dated 11 November 1981. The core of Fatih Education Faculty is the two-year Fatih Education Institute, which was opened in the 1963-1964 academic year. The education period was increased to three years in 1968. In 1978, the education period was increased to four years and it was named Fatih High School of Teachers. The Faculty, operating under the name of Fatih Faculty of Education within the body of Karadeniz Technical University until May 18, 2018, was connected to Trabzon University established in Trabzon with the law numbered 7141 published in the Official Gazette dated 18.05.2018 and numbered 30425.

The faculty moved to Fatih Campus of KTÜ, located in Söğütlü District of Akçaabat District in 1984. The faculty has a dean building, library, cultural center, except for the five block buildings called A, B, C, D and F, where the rooms of the classroom and teaching staff are located.

Considerable importance was attached to ensuring co-operation and partnership between the Faculty and schools in the community as a way of ensuring that the programs offered by the Faculty are not overly theoretical in nature. Parallel to this process, the amount of time dedicated to student participation in teaching experience and practicums has been increased. Furthermore, our faculty hosts many national and international meetings, in which we gather field experts and discuss current issues.

General Overview

Karadeniz Technical University Faculty of Fine Arts was established on April 29, 2004 and started its educational activities with the faculty building in Akçaabat district center of Trabzon, which has trained many artists in the field of fine arts. The faculty is art and design oriented, multi-disciplinary, structured in Bauhaus-based contemporary art approach in the light of developments in design, art and technology. There are three departments, namely Painting, Sculpture and Photography, within the faculty where the traditional workshop approach is adopted. Painting department took its first students in the academic year of 2009-2010, no students have been accepted to the Sculpture and Photography departments yet. The Faculty was affiliated to Trabzon University with the law numbered 7141 published in the Official Gazette dated 18.05.2018 and numbered 30425.

The faculty has all the necessary technological equipment to improve the quality of education. There are classrooms, pattern workshops, basic art education workshops, computer laboratories, multimedia lab, photography and editing studios, sculpture-modeling workshops, painting workshops, printing workshop, ceramic workshop, and exhibition hall within the faculty. In addition to the qualified education that students receive in the Faculty, they will be brought to the society as privileged artists who look to the future with confidence, thanks to the knowledge, experience and talents they have gained in contemporary art and scientific fields.

Our education staff, which has been getting richer since the beginning, consists of experienced and competent instructors. Students are admitted to our faculty with a special aptitude test.

General Overview

Karadeniz Technical University Faculty of Law was discussed in the University Senate's decision dated 18.05.2007 and numbered 211/10 and was established with the decision of the Council of Ministers dated 10.09.2007, published in the Official Gazette dated 26.12.2007 and numbered 26738. It was affiliated to Trabzon University, which was established with the law numbered 7141 published in the newspaper.

As Karadeniz Technical University Law Faculty, 20 students were taken for the first time in the 2008-2009 academic year and these students continued their education at Gazi University Law Faculty. Since the academic year of 2010-2011, our faculty has been providing education in the faculty classrooms within the central campus of the Black Sea Technical University in the 2009-2010 academic year.

Our faculty has strengthened both its academic and administrative staff since its foundation and has the youngest and dynamic jurist in the region.

School buildings in our hypothetical courtroom is one of the few salons in Turkey, it is better equipped than many real courtrooms. Our students are both prepared for national competitions and gaining real case experience by putting the theoretical knowledge they see in the course into practice. Our faculty, which continues its education in 2 classrooms and 8 classrooms, also has a reading room for students to study. Karadeniz Technical University Faculty of Theology, the University Senate's proposal dated 25/12/2009 and the approval of the General Assembly of Higher Education dated 04/02/2010, the letter of the Ministry of National Education dated 11/5/2010 and numbered 7934 and the Council of Ministers. was established in accordance with the additional article 30 of the Law numbered 2809 with the decision dated 24/5/2010 and numbered 2010/502, this decision came into force by being published in the Official Gazette dated July 1, 2010 and numbered 27628. The opening of departments and departments within the Faculty, the letter of the Rector's Office dated 02/11/2010 and numbered B.30.2.KTÜ.0.71.00.02 / 20199, at the meeting of the Higher Education Executive Board dated 02/02/2011, Law No. 2547 of Law No. 2547 According to the different 7 / d-2 article.

While being affiliated with Karadeniz Technical University, Trabzon University was established with the Article 188 of Law No. 7141 published in the Official Gazette dated May 18, 2018 and numbered 30425 and the 188th Additional Article added to the Law numbered 2809 and our faculty was connected to the said university.

General Overview

Upon the request of the Rector's Office of the Black Sea Technical University, upon the approval of YÖK and MEB (with the letter dated 09.06.2003 and numbered 14407), the Council of Ministers according to the Article 30 of the Law No. 2809 dated 28.03.1983, by the Council of Ministers, 17.06. It was established with the decision taken in 2003 (Decision Number: 2003/5782).

Our faculty left the Black Sea Technical University and started operating within Trabzon University with the law numbered 7141 published in the Official Gazette numbered 30425 dated 18.05.2018.

The Faculty became the 4th in the east of Ankara and the first Faculty of Communication in the Black Sea Region. In 2003, the structuring of the Faculty of Communication based on department was carried out in parallel with the academic structure of other communication faculties in our country. According to this configuration, the Faculty of Communication; It consists of three sections: Public Relations and Advertising, Journalism, Radio Television and Cinema.
